NUR-514 Organizational Leadership And Informatics Papers Course Description

This course examines the role of leadership, organizational science, policy, and informatics in supporting safe, high-quality, cost-effective patient care within interprofessional, dynamic health care environments. Learners explore various organizational relationships within health care systems and prepare to participate in the design of cost-effective, innovative models of care delivery and practice change proposals. Professional leadership theories and how they shape the nurse leader in such things as collaboration, conflict resolution, decision-making, and negotiation are introduced.

Learners discuss change management theories and evaluate the ethical, social, legal, economic, and political implications of practice change and health care informatics along with strategies for managing human, fiscal, and health care resources in a variety of organizational systems. Learners also examine the uses of patient-care, information systems, and communication technologies and discuss the design, implementation, and evaluation of electronic health record systems and clinical decision support systems.

As an advanced registered nurse, you will serve as a leader within your organization. Part of this role will entail being a change agent and spurring positive change on behalf of patients, colleagues, and the industry.

Consider a situation you experienced previously where change did not go as planned in your healthcare organization. Create a 10-15-slide PowerPoint presentation in which you will assess the situation and the steps that should have been taken to successfully implement change. Create speaker notes of 100-250 words for each slide. Include an additional slide for the title and references. For the presentation of your PowerPoint, use Loom to create a voice-over or a video. - As an advanced registered nurse, outline how you would initiate the change.
- Describe the impact to the organization if the change initiative is unsuccessful again, and potential steps the interprofessional team could take if the change is unsuccessful.
- Predict what additional factors will drive upcoming organizational change for the organization and outline the advanced registered nurse's role as change agent.

Topic 3 Discussion Question 1

Organizational change is usually necessary due to the dynamicity and advancements of processes and structures. Advancements in treatment and diagnostics, change in organizational structure, organizational goals, drives of organizational economy, or accreditation are some of the reasons for organizational change. In this dynamic environment, various change models or theories are usable (Udod & Wagner, 2018). The chaos Theory Model developed by a meteorologist, Edward Lorenz in the 1960s has been borrowed into nursing and is more effective in evolving organizational

environments. This uncommonly used model explains that small system changes in the organization can cause huge changes in the system and no organizational fraction can be thought apart.

How Organizational Change is Managed Using the Chaos Theory Model

This model drives managers to an understanding that every microsystem in the whole system is important and may contain small change opportunities that can impact a big outcome in the change management process (Olsson et al., 2020). Therefore, a manager has to explore as many contextual factors in a complex environment as possible to effectively implement change (Udod & Wagner, 2018). In this model, the manager addresses all dimensions of care in the change process in a dynamic and complex environment.

Role of Stakeholders

Stakeholders make up the fractal structures that cumulatively and collaboratively contribute to the larger systematic change. Stakeholders have to participate in the change planning and evaluation phases to ensure cooperation to prevent flung effects in other stakeholder roles (Demir et al., 2019). Stakeholder participation ensures inclusivity in change management according to the chaos theory model. Notably, this change model can also incorporate other models to ensure holistic success. Mixing ensures the survival of change in an unpredictable environment NUR-514 Organizational Leadership and Informatics Papers. All stakeholders that dem themselves noncontributory to a change process must be included to ensure that their

roles do not impact the bigger picture. In sum, the change provides a framework for change implementation that can be incorporated into other models

Topic 3 DQ 2

Description:

You have been selected to serve on a community outreach committee within your state's nursing organization. The committee includes registered nurses of different specialties. At your first meeting, it becomes evident that not everyone is in agreement with a recent position statement about the role of spiritual care, with some members arguing they will no longer support the committee if the position statement is not revised or reversed. As a nurse leader and change agent, how would you approach the

committee? How could you draw from change theory to address these concerns and encourage collaboration on the committee?

Topic 3 DQ 2 Sample

It is evident from the case that there exists a conflict among the committee's registered nurses. This conflict is arising from the difference in ideologies regarding a recent position statement about the role of spiritual care. There is a need for change to ensure the incorporation of spiritual care in nursing care. However, some nurses are opposed to this idea and would want this new care intervention reversed or revised.

As a change agent, there are various change models that I could use to influence the committee members to collaborate and promote conflict resolution. Implementation of spiritual care plan has created chaos and chaos is normative in healthcare delivery according to Weberg et al. (2018, p.15). To effect this change, I will consider both system and unit-specific needs.

In this situation, I will incorporate both Chaos theory and Lewin's Change theory. Chaos theory asserts that small system changes can greatly impact the outcomes and thus need to collaborate with every committee member to find the best solution (Olsson et al., 2020). Lewin's change model will provide the basic steps to manage conflict and effect change. My approach to the committee will start by assessing the problem by recognizing both driving and restraining forces (Denisco, 2019). In the unfreezing phase according to Lewin's change model, I will agitate the equilibrium state by providing evidence-based information regarding the need for change opposers of change to acquire more information regarding the need and benefits of change.

This information provision will be considered as the most restraining and driving factors possible per Chaos Theory. In the change phase, I will influence all committee members to view the change from a new perspective that does not lean toward individual interests in the change. The collaboration with each committee member will aim at creating a common goal in the change and refreezing phase. Therefore, applying both the Chaos and Lewin Theories will promote conflict resolution through collaboration and compromise to effect change.

- Describe the measures and steps you would take to evaluate the success of the EHR implementation from a staff, setting, and patient perspective to measure effectiveness and ensure continuous quality improvement in practice?
- Explain what leadership skills and theories would be needed to facilitate collaboration with the interprofessional team and provide evidence-based, patient-centered care.
